- 2 Four annual awards namely Sahitya Akademi Award, Translation Prize, Bala Sahitya Puraskar, Yuva Puraskar: Bhasha Sammans and Fellowships to eminent writers for outstanding contribution in the field of Literature.
- 3 Organizing programmes like seminars, translation workshops, Language Conventions, literary forums, Kavi/Katha Sandhi, Meet the Author, People and Books, Nari Chetna, Yuva Sahiti, Purvottari(programmes for North East), Loka, Bala Sahiti covering all the 24 languages.
- 4 Encourage and support young writers under a scheme of Navodaya and also Travel Grant which is for writers of 40 years and below.
- 5 Organizing annual week long Literary Festival which covers seminars/literary programmes, oral and folk tradition, samvatsar lecture.
- 6 Organizing year-long programmes in various region of India in local languages.
- 7 Organizing and participating in numerous Cultural and Literary exchange programmes in several countries. Participating in Book Fairs around world as part of promoting Indian Literature Abroad.
